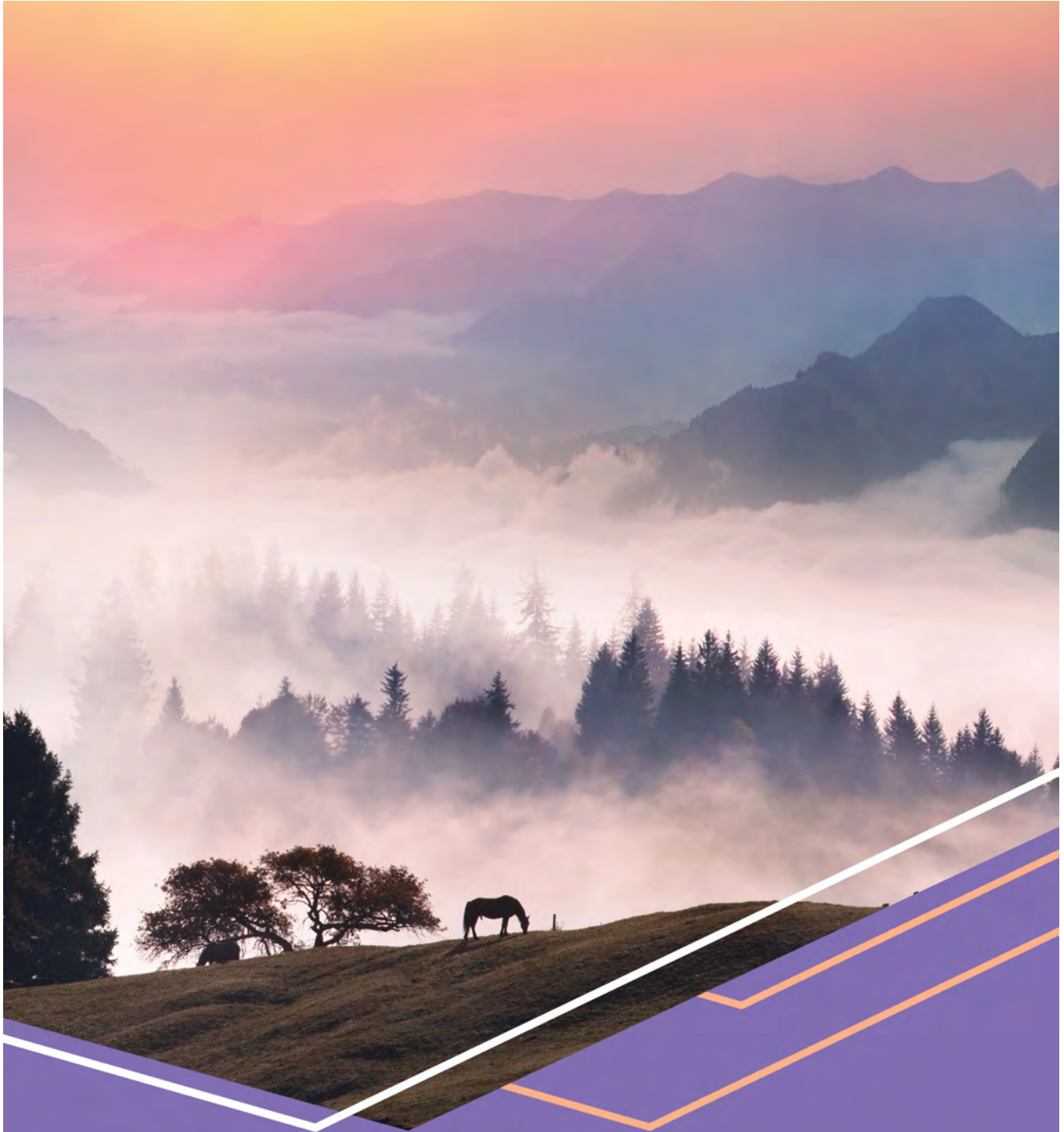

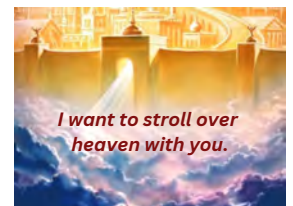

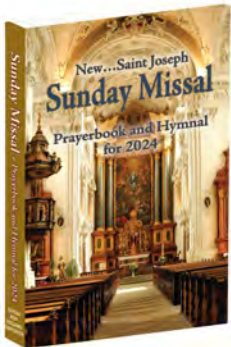
# Support the 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal

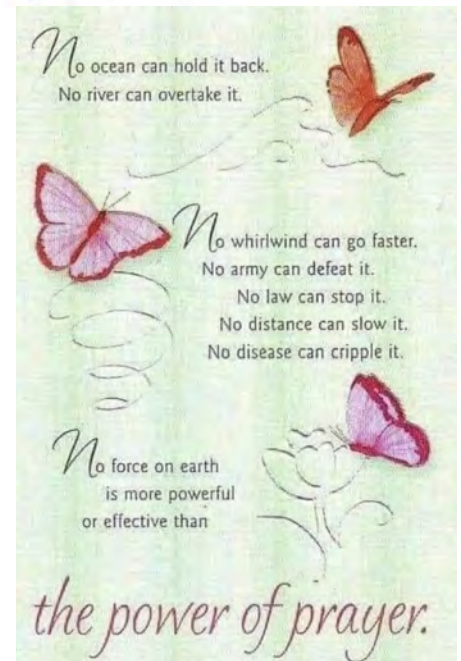

## YOUTH & FAMILIES

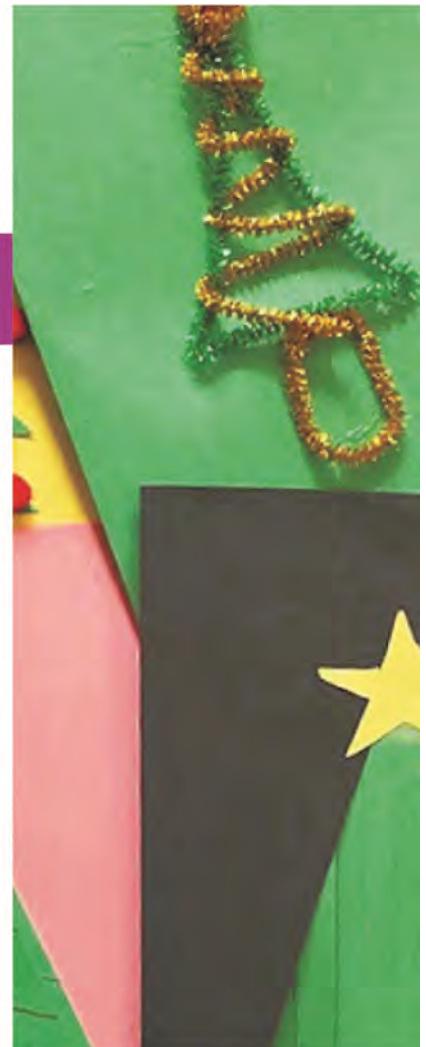
